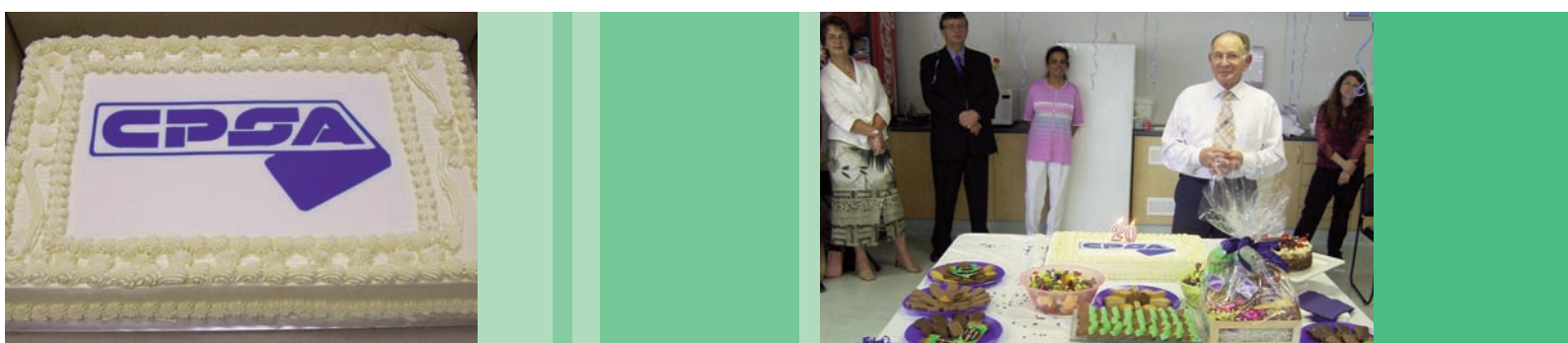

- Full height glass to maximise sunlight;
- High performance double glazing system using low E coatings;
- High efficiency lighting and energy efficient hot water heating;
- Sensor activated taps to reduce water usage;
- Sensor lighting in the car park and other areas in non-continuous use to reduce energy consumption.



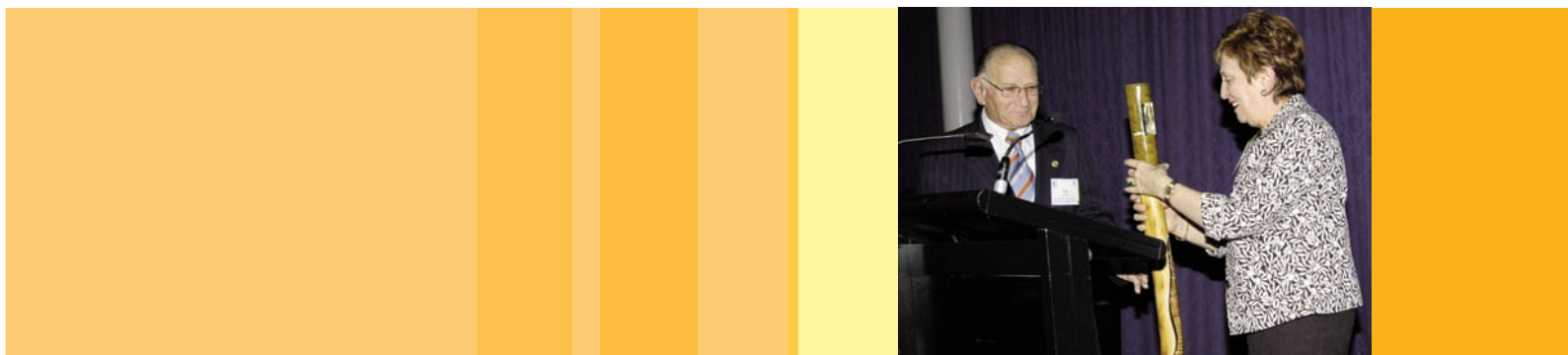
QUALITY ASSURANCE

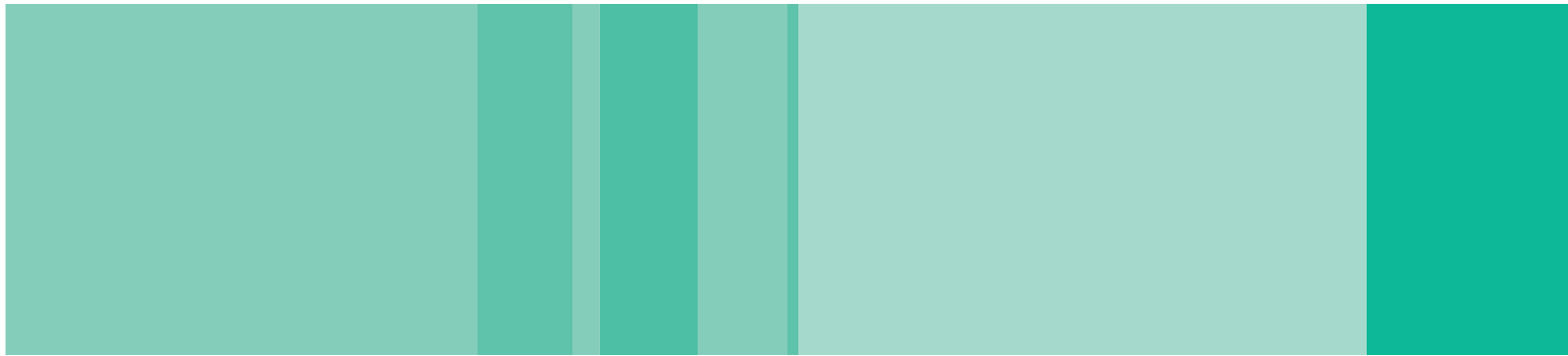
STAFF PROFILE
